Amendment to Resolution Regarding Pay Codes Included as Pensionable Income

In accordance with the provisions of the California Public Employees' Pension Reform Act of 2012 (AB 340), the Board of Retirement for the Tulare County Employees' Retirement Association (TCERA) determined on November 7, 2012, those Tulare County pay codes that are to be included in "compensation earnable for the calculation of retirement benefits paid by TCERA. The TCERA Board of Retirement is aware that additional pay codes have been approved by Tulare County and takes this action to amend the list of pay codes from the Retirement Board action of November 7, 2012. Each of the new pay codes will be included or excluded as part of compensation earnable for the purpose of calculating pension benefits in accordance with the following list:
