1. Review of Committee Minutes from the meeting of June 25, 2020. Motion to approve minutes as presented.

  - a. TCERA and TCERA Property, Inc. Financial Statements May 31, 2020

## c. TCERA Board Room Technology Upgrade

The committee reviewed the proposal from Serban Sound, Staff's recommended vendor. Ms. Warner explained that Serban Sound has experience with Tulare County and provided the most comprehensive, competitive, and responsive proposal. In addition, Tulare County Information Technology and Communications (TCiCT) had reviewed all the information submitted and concurs with Staff's recommendation. The proposal was structured in a building block format, allowing the committee to determine the level of investment that is most desirable and beneficial. All options include installation of equipment and required cabling. In addition, on-site training and support for implementation is included. After a lengthy discussion over the different technology options the committee decided that Option D, would be the best option for the Board Room. Option D entails the following: Upgrade speaker, microphones, and recording/teleconferencing system to be managed using a Creston touch screen device. Install flat screen television and related equipment for internet connectivity and presentations. Cost for this option is \$53,364.32. This amount is over the estimated amount of \$46,000 that was budget. The overage will be pulled from TCERA's special projects budget of \$20,000.

Motion to recommend to the Board of Retirement the proposal from Serban Sound Option D for TCERA's Board Room technology upgrade.

# d. Ratify Administrator Action for Surplus Equipment

Ms. Warner informed the committee that the policy regarding the disposal of TCERA assets that grants the Administrator the authority to make decisions regarding equipment with an estimated value of \$500 or less per item. The policy also requires that such actions be reported to the Administrative Committee for ratification. Attached is two lists of equipment that the Administrator has authorized to be transferred to the Tulare County Surplus Store.

Motion to ratify Administrator actions regarding disposal of inoperable and obsolete equipment.
